2. **Help with younger grades on Wednesday nights** during your off weeks.

5. **40 Days for Life:** Spend an hour praying outside of Planned Parenthood for an end to abortion.
6. **Church Spring Clean-Up.** Watch the bulletin. This usually takes place in March/April.
7. **Praying for the Dead:** Visit a cemetery and pray for the souls of those who have died.
8. **Totus Tuus** (June): High school volunteers are needed to help in classrooms, with games, organizing snacks, and more at our summer faith formation program.
9. **Camp Summit** (August): Join the FIAT Team or Prayer Team at Camp Summit, a middle school camp at Eagle Bluff Nature Center. The week includes leading small groups, prayer, performing skits, and encouraging the younger students.
10. **Fall Festival Volunteer** (October): Helping with the annual Fall Festival
